RE: Mrs Joanne Richardson (5B) Resignation

I am writing to inform you that Mrs Joanne Richardson, has formally resigned from her position as Year 5B teacher, effective Friday 27th May. Unfortunately, a health concern has resulted in Mrs Richardson feeling unable to carry out her role as a classroom teacher to the standard she expects and is deserving of the children in her care. Whilst it has been a very difficult decision, Mrs Richardson feels this is in the best interests of the children.

We are currently in the process of appointing a suitable replacement/s for 5B and will aim to minimise the disruption to the children. We are hopeful of announcing the new teacher/s by the conclusion of Week 4.

Naturally, parents may be concerned about the disruption for their children but please be assured we will do our best to make this as seamless as possible. Mrs Nicole Bond will continue to support the Year 5 cohort in her role as 5W teacher.
